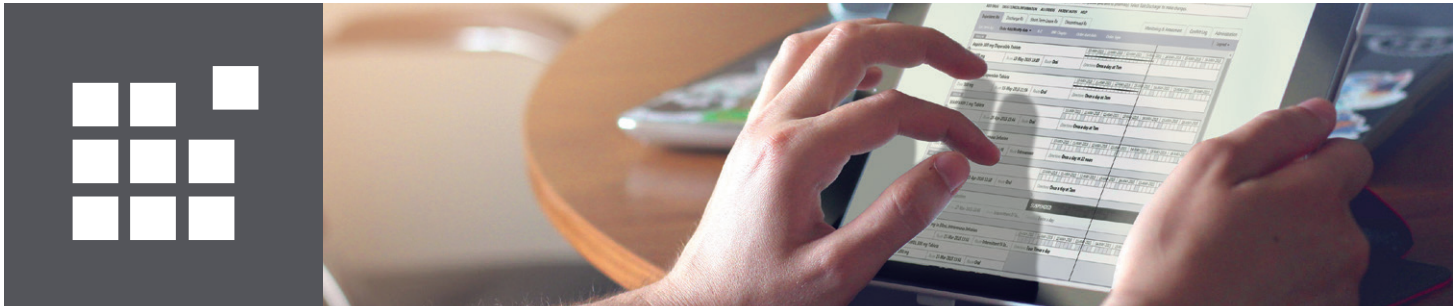
Providing seamless operation of e-Homecare services at the care purchaser and provider interface

Delivering Benefits:

- Increases administrative capacity to deliver Homecare Services.
- Reduces human error in Homecare administrative processes.

The JAC Homecare Module enables secondary care trusts to increase their capacity to utilise homecare services by reducing the administrative burden associated with ordering, invoicing and recording of dispensed items to a patient. The Homecare Module automates processes that were previously carried out manually and integrates with the existing JAC functionality.



The JAC Homecare Module Provides:

Support for the Homecare Framework

The central concept of the Homecare module is the Homecare Framework. The JAC Homecare module enables customers to build Homecare Framework Agreements. Once established, medicines can be added to a Framework Agreement for a specific clinical indication. Sundry items, such as injecting equipment, can also be added. Recording patient consent completes the requirements necessary to create Homecare Requests for supply.

Support for Homecare Requests

These require the specification of a total quantity of each item on the request along with a supply interval and period. A calculate function is incorporated in the Homecare Module to assist with this.

Support for Invoice Processing

Once an invoice is received in respect of a Homecare Request, the module will enable the end-user to input delivered quantities of items, optional Homecare charges, postage and packaging charges along with service fees.

The Homecare module then automates several processes into a single process: booking the item in; issuing the item to the nominated patient; placing a record in the patient's dispensing history (differentiated as a Homecare transaction); passing the invoice for payment; producing an invoice for the Care Purchaser (e.g. PCT, CCGs).

Tracking and Reporting

The Homecare Module facilitates tracking of active Homecare Requests. In addition, there are a number of built-in reports; the following are a selection:

- Identify all existing Homecare Frameworks
- Spend per Homecare Framework
- Care Purchaser spend per Homecare Framework

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
